

On the last day, I told Dr. Jim and Kathleen Kaseman that this was by far the best AFCM conference I've yet attended. They weren't surprised at my comments as all ministers from the United States would benefit in a discovery of a more global perspective of what God is doing throughout the world.

The conference praise and worship was excellent. There was certainly an uncompromised presentation of the Word with all the speakers. The skits done by the Pacific Islanders – some of the "friendly cannibals" – were hilarious.

Brother Jim Newton set the tone for the conference with "reaching the nations with faith." His primary text was Mark 1:38 where Jesus proclaimed to His disciples, "Let us go into the next towns, that I may preach there also, because for this purpose I have come forth."

Within our delegate packet, we were given a business card with "souls" printed all over it and the book "The Passion for Souls" by Oswald J. Smith. Smith is the Canadian 20th century mission's statesman who is

best known for the quote, "Why should anyone hear the Gospel twice before everyone has heard it once?"

It is reported that even though the United States has less than 6% of the world's population, it has over 95% of the world's Christian ministers. We need to think outside our American box and borders as the Lord commissioned us all to go and send preachers "to all the world and preach the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15).

One of the conference speakers was Dick McLellan an Australian who left his native land to take the Gospel into previously inaccessible regions as a missionary to Ethiopia. McLellan pointed out that there is no "or" found in Acts 1:8, "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

This international conference reinforced in me a resolve to think beyond the four walls of our church with outreaches beyond our immediate community with a vision that also includes "the end of the earth."



MULTIPLYING MINISTRIES

In Matthew, Chapter 24, verse 14, it says: "And this gospel of the Kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations and then the end will come." You know what? Where the Gospel is preached, we are going to find the results that we read about. Wonderful things are going to happen. Lives will change, and that's called ministry.

There are so many changes that are going on right now that the Lord has — I'll just go ahead and say it — has mandated for us to step up into. But, there are things that we've got to do, because it's not just about building us up, it's about reaching out to other people, and ultimately, about bringing glory to God. There's been a shift. It's almost like the lanes have widened, and where we were on two, three, maybe four lanes of building up saints, the Lord has now just widened it on both sides. He is spreading us out, going in the same direction, the same crew, the same bunch, adding to it, but getting us into a place where we are not just building up, but we are reaching out. We're touching people, but we can't touch people with programs; we can't touch people with good ideas. You have to touch people with the Good News of the Gospel. So, keep your eyes open, keep your heart open, and be praying, because our future, truly, is paved in prayer. Ministry must be multiplied, needs must be met, the Gospel must be preached, people must be saved, lives have to be changed, people have to be disciplined and matured; and then it has to cycle all over again.

You know, God's work in your life is not just to bring you to a place where you are happy and blessed. It's to bring you to a place where you are strong, and you are able to then go ahead and be a blessing and a help to other people. The whole thing ends — it just ends — if it's just about you. But it's not just about us. Thank God, we're included in it. When the saints go marching in, we'll be in that number, but it's not just about us. Now, go with me to Acts, Chapter 6, verse 7. It says, "And the Word of God spread and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly..." One translation said "exponentially." Another one says "rapidly." "...the number of disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests were obedient to the faith." Not only were the number of disciples multiplied greatly — now get this — not just added to, but multiplied greatly! It says even a great many religious people — and this is my paraphrase — came alive. The Message Bible says the Word of God prospered. The number of disciples in Jerusalem increased dramatically; a great many priests submitted themselves to the faith. In Acts 12:24, it says that "...the Word of God grew and multiplied." The Message Bible says, "Meanwhile, the ministry of God's Word grew by leaps and bounds." I like that! Acts 19:20 says, "So the word of the Lord grew mightily and prevailed." So that means as loud as we can, as far as we can, and as clear as we can, we're to declare this Good News. Why? Because it changes lives and multiplies ministries!

This is the season when we are reminded of how much we have to be thankful for—especially God's great plan of salvation for mankind.

Separated From God

Sin entered the world through Adam's disobedience, resulting in mankind's separation from God. And death spread to all men (Gen. 2:17; 3:6; I Tim. 2:14; Rom. 5:12).

Jesus Our Substitute

Man became a slave to sin and Satan. He could not redeem himself. God sent His only Son to become our substitute to pay the penalty of sin in full through His suffering, death, burial, resurrection, and shed blood (Luke 24:46-47; John 3:16).

Genesis 3:15 records the first implicit prophetic promise of God's plan of redemption for the world. God promised that Christ would be born of a woman and would be "bruised" through His crucifixion. Yet He would rise from the dead to completely destroy (bruise) Satan, sin, and death for the sake of the salvation of the human race.

Genesis 12:3 is the second prophecy in scripture concerning the coming of Jesus Christ. It speaks of a spiritual blessing that would come through Abraham's seed. The Apostle Paul states that the seed (singular) is Christ Jesus (Gal. 3:16), and that blessing refers to the Gospel of Christ offered to all nations (Gal. 3:8, 16). God's promise to Abraham reveals that from the very beginning, the purpose of the Gospel was to bless all the nations with salvation and goodness.

Isaiah 7:14 says that a virgin shall conceive and bear a son... Immanuel. The ultimate fulfillment of this prophecy was realized in the birth of Jesus Christ by the Virgin Mary (Matt. 1:23; Luke 1:31-33).

The conception of her son came about by a miracle of the Holy Spirit rather than through the act of man.

Jesus the Blessing

We see then that the blessing to all nations through the seed of Abraham (Jesus) was repentance and forgiveness (remission) of our sins through the shed blood of Jesus. Not only for the Jews (Israel), but also for the Gentiles (Acts 3:19-26; 5:30-32; Gal.

3:13-14). It is repentance and forgiveness that brings us into the presence of God (Acts 3:19; Col. 1:13-14).

The Promise of the Father

In Acts 1:4-8, Jesus told His disciples to wait for the promise of the Father which was the Holy Spirit. It was through the Holy Spirit that they would receive power to live the Christian life and be witnesses to all the world.

So the Blessing of Abraham is remission of sins through the shed blood of Jesus and the promise of the Father is the Holy Spirit who gives us power to live the Christian life (Acts 2:38-39, Gal. 3:14).

Thankful Children

As children of God we have much to be thankful for. Because of God's grace we can come into His presence through Jesus Christ which is given to us by the Holy Spirit who imparts God's mercy, forgiveness, and the grace or power to do the will of God.

God's grace enables man to come into God's presence through Jesus the Blessing.

Once we receive the blessing (salvation), then we receive the promise of the Father, the Holy Spirit, who gives us the operational power to live the Christian life. Glory to God! What an awesome God we serve!

May this be the best Thanksgiving and Christmas season ever for you and your entire household!

For those who have not received the blessing and the promise, pray the following prayer and receive.

God, I know I am a sinner and I need your help. I believe in my heart that Jesus Christ is your Son, that he died on the cross for my sins and God raised Him from the dead. Jesus, right now I open my heart and invite you to come in. Make yourself real to me. Take control of my life and make me the person you want me to be. Be my Lord and Savior. And now I ask to be baptized (filled) with your precious Holy Spirit so that I may have your power and ability to live the Christian life. By faith I believe I have received in Jesus' name. Amen.
