



### The Creation of Man

God did not create man for death. Man was designed for eternal fellowship with God. He was created in God's very own image and likeness. He was created for joy, happiness, and peace. And he was created to give God pleasure (Psalm 8:3-6; Genesis 1:26-27; Revelation 4:11).

God gave man a place in His creation second only to Himself, with dominion as far reaching as the universe itself (Psalm 8:3-6). Adam was the master of himself, of creation, and of Satan.

### The Fall of Man

Adam did not have to yield to sin. He had been given a free will with the power to choose to obey or disobey God. But Adam did the unthinkable. Adam knowingly committed high treason against God by selling out to Satan the dominion which God had originally given him. Adam's treason was done on such a legal basis that God could not annul the contract He had made with Adam, and which Adam had passed on to Satan. Hence, Satan, not Adam. became the god of this world (II Cor. 4:4). And thus began Satan's destructive reign. And sin and death spread to all men (Romans 5:12), who became slaves to sin and Satan (Romans 6:16-17; I John 3:10b).

### God's Plan — The Incarnation

Before the beginning of time God had a plan of redemption in His heart for mankind (Titus 1:2). God would assume the liabilities of man's transgressions and redeem him from Satan's dominion. His plan would allow man's nature to be changed back into God's nature, setting man free from spiritual death and causing him to be made spiritually alive (Ephesians 2:1-7).

God's love for His creation compels Him to punish sin. Otherwise, sin unpunished would spread like cancer and destroy His entire

creation. God is just and justice demanded that the penalty for man's crime be paid, but man himself was unable to pay it since he was a slave to sin and Satan. Therefore, because man couldn't save himself, God Himself became man's Redeemer! The incarnation was the only solution to the human problem — the only hope for mankind to be reunited with God (John 1:1, 14).

The incarnation is defined as the union of divinity (God) with humanity in Jesus Christ. The prophet Isaiah prophesied the incarnation 750 years before Jesus was born: "...Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel" (Isaiah 7:14). Immanuel means "God with us" or "Incarnation." Initially the incarnation was prophesied in Genesis 3:15 as the seed of a woman (a supernatural birth), since in normal birth it is the seed of a man, then fulfilled in Luke 1:31-35; Gal. 4:4, etc.

### **Oualifications Are Met**

The importance of the virgin birth cannot be overemphasized. In order for our Redeemer to qualify to pay for sins and bring salvation, He must be, in one person, fully human, sinless and fully divine (Hebrews 7:25-28). The virgin birth satisfies all three of these requirements: (1) the only way Jesus could be born a human being was to be born of a woman. Philippians 2:6-8 tells us that Christ has always existed in the form of God. But He emptied Himself and took the form of a bond servant, being made in the likeness of men. This suggests a distinct operation of God totally different from natural generation: a miracle. First, God took Christ from the Godhead in heaven — and then He placed Christ in the womb of a virgin to be united with flesh in a unique conception. God prepared a body – a special body – for this Being called the Son of God. In the Incarnation, Christ became a man! (Hebrews 10:5). (2) the only way He could be sinless was to be conceived by the Holy Spirit. Matthew 1:20b tells us, "... do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit." (3) The only way He could be divine was to have God as His Father. As a result His conception was not by natural but by supernatural means. "That holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God" (Luke 1:35). Jesus Christ is therefore revealed to us as one divine person with two natures — divine and sinless human.

### Conclusion

Too frequently people simply look at the physical side of Jesus' birth and talk about His being born as a babe, when He actually preexisted with the Father from the beginning. He then became our Redeemer when He took on the form of a man in a flesh body. In living and suffering as a human person, Jesus sympathizes with our weaknesses (Hebrews 4:15-16). As the Divine Son of God He has the power to deliver us from sin's bondage and Satan's power (Col. 2:15; Hebrews 2:14). As both divine and sinless human, He qualifies to serve as a sacrifice for the sins of every person and as
